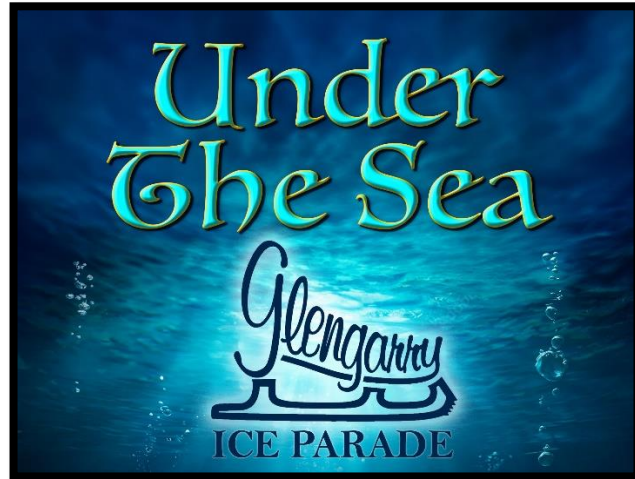

The schedule will be sent out in the next week or so. Registration has just closed and we are now finalizing the groupings. Instructions for ordering pictures will also be sent at that time.

50/50

We are holding another 50/50, to coincide with the Ice Parade. It will be online again using the same platform as the Christmas draw.
